- Something like the [baKno splash](#) would look good, be memorable, and should be easy to animate
- You could also play on the "airbrushed metal" look that modern Macs have. Maybe start out with a gray metal texture like the screen before the login window, and have the MGS name + logo appear suddenly impressed into the metal, like a stamp.
- You could also animate the logo itself to make the significance clear. Start out with the light blue head munching leftward, accompanied by pacman sounds, then have it meet the dark blue head munching rightward - forming the MGS logo. And when they meet you could play the signature Mac OS startup sound!
